The Inner Space Center (ISC) at URI's Graduate School of Oceanography in Narragansett, RI, offers an Ocean Science Exploration Camp for youth ages 11-15. During this weeklong day camp, ocean explorers engage in hands-on activities and investigations, tune into live oceanographic expeditions, meet scientists, and learn about different ocean careers.

The summer 2016 session will take place August 15-19, 2016, and will focus on chemical oceanography. Campers will conduct field and lab-based experiments to learn about and measure important water characteristics including temperature, salinity, pH, turbidity, dissolved oxygen, and nutrient levels, as well as investigate the potential impacts of climate change and marine pollutants on the ocean ecosystem.
